

How to configure External Device Control Settings for Mac OS Profile

Click 'Configuration Templates' > 'Profiles' > open a Mac profile > 'External Device Control'

- The external device control option blocks devices of a client computer from accessing, such as USB drives, Bluetooth devices, printers, and serial and parallel ports.
- This Option manages the list of devices to which you want to block access that should be blocked on endpoints using this profile

Configure External Device Control settings

- Log into Comodo One / Dragon
- Click 'Applications' > 'Endpoint Manager'
- Click 'Configuration Templates' > 'Profiles'
- Open the MAC profile you want to work on.
 - Open the 'External Device Control' tab and click 'Edit'
